IDEAA Infusion into Curriculum	Lori Pullman Lori mentioned discussed IDEAA Principles and Practice developed by the California Community Colleges Curriculum Committee (CCCCC). This was discussed at the Curriculum Institute she attended in the most recent summer. She mentioned the college Curriculum Committee's responsibility to look for specific IDEAA language in course outlines. She will send out samples for the committee for reference.

AB 1111 (Common Course Numbering) AB 928 (CalGETC)	The State has recently made available the templates for the upcoming set of 6 courses a that need to be revised, to meet AB 1111. Lori will send the templates to the affiliated Departments. (English, Critical Thinking, Political Science, Psychology, Communications/Public Speaking, and Statistics). The templates are also available on the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office website. Key language will need to be used for all of the courses assigned for common course numbering. This is to add to the course description. Additional language for course descriptions can still be included. Manoj Wickremesinghe Manoj mentioned that the current approved IGETC courses will automatically meet CalGETC requirements. Our college needs to work on developing more courses in
	the Communication Studies area, to meet CalGETC standards.
Local AA/AS GE pattern updates	Lori Pullman The Committee discussed the proposed changes to the local AA and AS degrees to be brought up to Academic Senate. These changes are due to Title V regulations for the addition of the Ethnic Studies area, for local degrees. The proposed adjustments cause area D to lose 9 units in the AA requirement. The committee discussed how greatly this will affect the Social Science enrollments. The committee, with some notes from Kevin Henson, the Social Science Division Dean, and Jessica Gonzalez, Social Science Division Representative, mentioned that this would not greatly affect their Social Science enrollments. This is due to the fact that the majority of these students are on different academic pathways. The committee held voting on the proposed local GE patterns until members can see additional data. Lori will research the degrees and programs affected by these changes, and get this information to the Committee.
Articulation Update	Manoj Wickremesinghe The Committee was updated on the status of the most recent series of articulation submissions. Manoj will contact the individual Departments of the courses that were not approved, and will send the reasoning for the denials.
